1. General statement

Section 431(c) of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017 states:

“If the Registrar either receives an answer from the company to the effect that it is not carrying on business, or does not within 28 days after sending the second notice receive any answer, he may publish in the Gazette, and send to the company by any means referred to in sub-section (a) a notice that, at the expiration of three months from the date of that notice, the name of the company mentioned therein will, unless cause is shown to the contrary, be struck off the Register and the company will be dissolved.”

2. Further Notice from Registrar

The company previously received two Notices from the Registrar under Section 431 of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017 regarding whether the company is carrying on business. The Registrar has not received a response from the company.

Pursuant to section 431(c) of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017, the Registrar hereby provides this Notice to the company that a notification has been published in the Gazette to strike off the company. Unless cause is shown to the contrary, the name of the company will be struck off the Register and the company will be dissolved on the expiration of three months from the date of this Notice.

The company may respond to this Notice by completing Form 1-4A within 3 months from the date of this Notice. If a response from the company is not received within this period, the company will be struck off the Register.
